WORDS FROM THE PASTOR

The Power of the Gospel!

To speak of evangelism as an activity that only looks to inform others about a belief or a religion, does not make much sense if first we do not correctly understand it for what it is, to communicate the Gospel, and the Gospel is nothing but the **Good News of Salvation**. That is why, it is **VERY** important that before even wanting to share it with others, we ask ourselves what we understand about the Gospel. And if we understand it correctly, what evidence is there, in our lives, that proves it? This is the reason why Jesus calls us to be "**witnesses**". Only a witness, who has lived, has experienced, has been a part of something, can truly share with other what he knows. **The Gospel is not about information, but about transformation**. Once we are transformed, we can be effective in being tools, instruments, so that others can be transformed. And not that this depends on us, but Jesus wanted it to happen that way. **Acts 1: 8 (NLT)** tells us; **but they will receive power when the Holy Spirit descends upon you; and they will be my witnesses, and they will speak to the people about me everywhere: in Jerusalem, throughout Judea, in Samaria and to the farthest corners of the earth.**
